#### What is UAT?

• User Acceptance Testing

- Purpose:
  - 1. to ensure that your new site was built according to the approved **graphic design** and **wireframe**
  - 2. To fix as many possible issues at once
  - 3. Address change requests to design and functionality

#### **Types of Issues - Design**

- What is a design issue?
  - An aspect of the site that displays differently than what was <u>signed off on</u> in the wireframe and final graphic design
- Examples:
  - Colors not matching design comps
    - Link color
    - Text color
    - Hover color
  - Mega menu link spacing
  - Font
    - Family, size, weight, etc.

#### **Types of Issues - Functionality**

- What is a Functionality issue?
  - Functionality that is missing or not working according to the wireframe
- Examples:
  - Hero image behavior (rotate automatically vs. manual selection)
  - Widget settings ("view more" link does not work, emergency banner needs to be enabled)

#### **Types of Issues - Mobile**

- What is a mobile issue?
  - A functionality/design issue that can only be duplicated on a mobile device.
- Examples:
  - Mobile mega menu does not expand
  - Hero image distortion

#### What is **NOT** an Issue?

#### • Homepage links

 These require initial set up. The developers built the functionality now they need to be told where to go.

#### Content-related items

- These are editable items that require initial set-up/updating
  - Button titles
  - Top navigation link titles
  - Footer phone numbers or address
  - <u>All</u> interior page content

#### What is **<u>NOT</u>** an Issue? (cont'd)

#### • Zooming in or out

– The intended viewing resolution of the site is 100%.

#### • Hover while in mobile/responsive view

 Hover is not possible with touch screens, so this is not included in the site specifications.
